# **FIRST AID MEASURES**

**Eye Contact:** If the impregnating fluid comes into direct contact with the eyes immediately flush

with plenty of water. If irritation develops seek medical advice.

# **FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES**

Suitable extinguishing media: Water spray, foam, carbon dioxide and dry powder.

Standard protective equipment should be worn by fire-fighters.
